COMPETITION RULES: ITKF Competition Rules

1. Participants of the III European Children's Cup are members of the ITKF Member Federations and of other European Traditional Karate partner organizations and clubs.

2. There are **no limitations as to the number of participating athletes / teams** from one country / club.

3. It is required that at least 4 athletes / teams participate in one category in order to start competition in this category. In case of insufficient number of contestants for a particular category, they will be incorporated in another group of similar age and grade.
